

THE TOWN OF HAMPTON'S COMMUNITY POWER AGGREGATION PROGRAM



The Town of Hampton is pleased to announce that it has selected First Point Power as the electricity supplier for its Community Power Aggregation Program ("Program"). This Program is a municipal aggregation which enables local government to combine the purchasing power of its residents and businesses to provide them with an alternative electricity supply option. The Town voted to authorize the Program plan at Town Meeting in March 2023, and selected Colonial Power Group as an energy consulting company to manage the Program.

The town is holding a public information session about the Program on April 4, 2024, at 6:00PM in the Selectmen's Meeting Room at Town Hall. The session will be conducted to field any questions and to assist consumers to make informed decisions about participation.

Unitil and Eversource have provided information to the town showing that you fall into one or more of the customer groups described in the table below. Most consumers in town will be automatically enrolled in the Program unless they opt out. **However, you will NOT be automatically enrolled in the Program when it launches in May 2024 for the reasons noted below**.

Consumer Group	Reason you will NOT be automatically enrolled in the Program in May 2024
Eversource Default Service consumer	Eversource's current Default Service rate is lower than Hampton's Program rate.
Consumer receiving supply from a competitive supplier	The Program will not automatically enroll a consumer receiving supply from an alternative competitive supplier so as not to interfere with any underlying agreement. Before requesting to join the Program, you should confirm with your supplier that you will not incur any fees for leaving their service.
Net metering consumer (roof-top or community solar)	Net metering consumers might not benefit from participating in the Program. Such consumers may lose certain benefits that only Unitil and Eversource can provide through Default Service. For more information visit www.colonialpowergroupnh.com/net-metering/
