

THE TOWN OF HAMPTON'S COMMUNITY POWER AGGREGATION PROGRAM CONSUMER NOTIFICATION

The Town of Hampton is pleased to announce that it has selected First Point Power as the electricity supplier for its Community Power Aggregation Program ("Program"). This Program is a municipal aggregation which enables local government to combine the purchasing power of its residents and businesses to provide them with an alternative to Unitil Default Service. The Town voted to authorize the Program plan at Town Meeting in March 2023, and selected Colonial Power Group as an energy consulting company to manage the Program.

The town is holding a public information session about the Program April 4, 2024, at 6:00PM in the Selectmen's Meeting Room at Town Hall.

PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM WILL NOT CHANGE YOUR ELECTRICITY SERVICE. You will continue to receive one bill from Unitil. The only difference you will see is that "Hampton CPA Program" will be printed under the "Supplier" section of your monthly bill. You will continue to send your payments to your Unitil for processing. Unitil will continue to respond to emergencies, read meters and maintain the distribution and transmission lines. Energy Assistance consumers will continue to receive the same benefits from Unitil.

COMPARATIVE RATES AND TERMS (Supply Services Only)

IF YOU ARE A UNITIL DEFAULT SERVICE CONSUMER WHO HAS BEEN MAILED A NOTIFICATION you do not need to take any action to participate in the Program. You will be AUTOMATICALLY enrolled in the Program and start benefiting from the Program rate beginning on the day of the month in May 2024 that your meter is read (as shown on your bill).

WATCH YOUR UNITIL BILL FOR FURTHER NOTIFICATION of the Program.

- Your May 2024 bill will state that you are being switched to Hampton's Program.
- Your June 2024 bill will show the Program's name and Program rate under "Supplier".

IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO PARTICIPATE IN THS PROGRAM you may OPT-OUT by

- 1) Signing and returning the Opt-Out Reply Card included with the mailed notification OR
- 2) Visit <u>colonialpowergroupnh.com/hampton</u>, click the OPT-OUT button and follow the instructions **OR**
- 3) Call First Point Power at (888) 875-1711 and ask to remain on Unitil Default Service.

IF YOU WISH TO JOIN THIS PROGRAM you may OPT-IN at <u>colonialpowergrouph.com/hampton</u> **OR** call First Point Power at (888) 875-1711 and ask to be enrolled. If you are currently contracted directly with a competitive supplier, you should confirm with them that you will not incur any early termination fees or penalties for leaving their supply.

NOTE: SOLAR PANEL AND COMMUNITY SOLAR CONSUMERS might not benefit from participating in the Program and therefore will NOT be automatically enrolled.
